## Exporting References from EconLit Into RefWorks

1. Perform a search in EconLit and mark the references you want to export by selecting the **select** icon to the right of each record.
2. When you have completed your search and added all items to the folder, select the **items** icon which is located on the upper right side of the results list.
3. Select **Export** located on the right hand side directly above the results list.
4. Make sure that you are in the Save tab, rather than the Email tab. Select what you like to **Remove these items from folder after saving**.

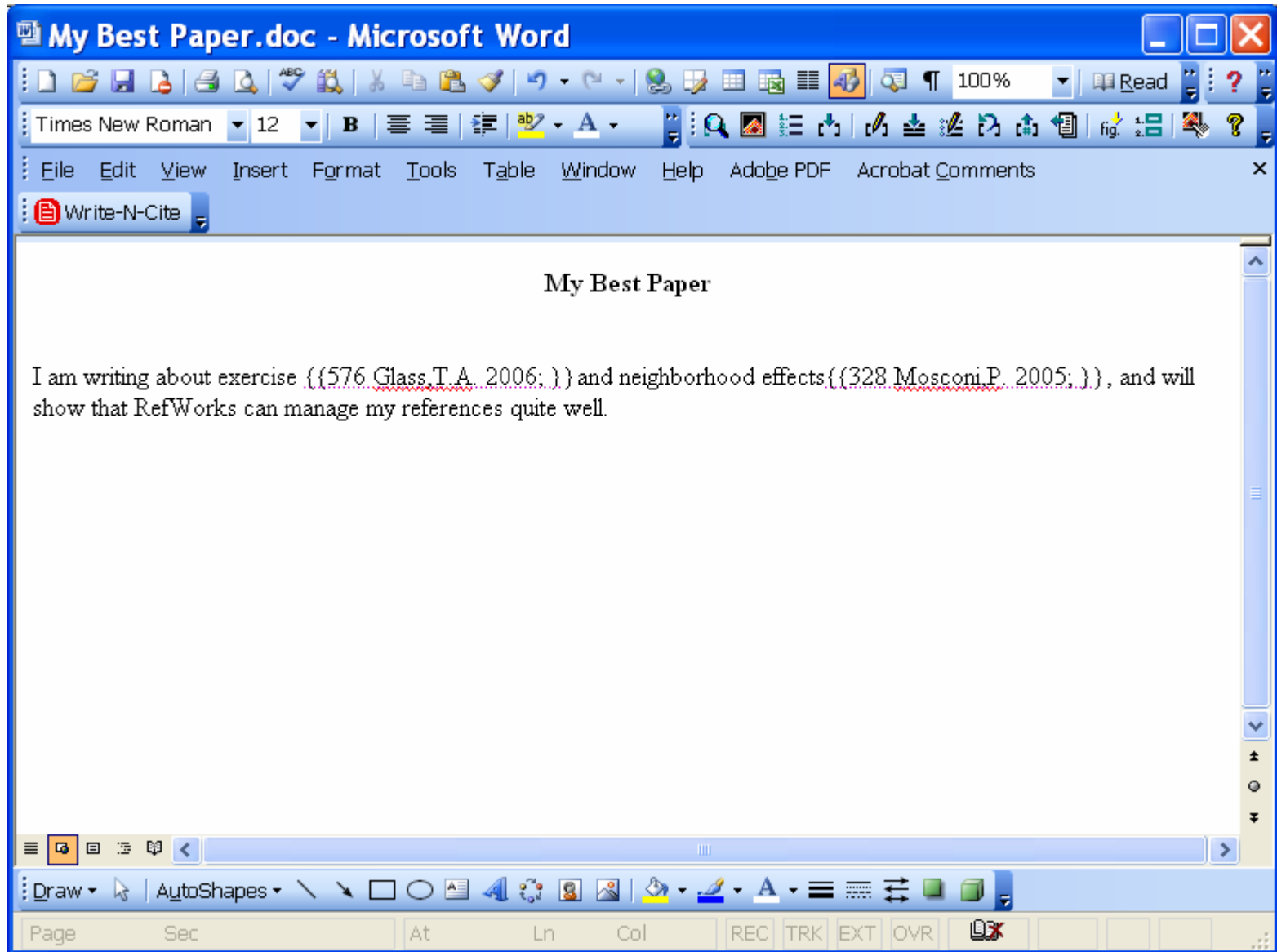
